Noise and sound quality on location: HarbourSide	Yet again, it will be noisy so we will mute the audio picked up and play Daniels V/O over it.	
Set dressing and props: Suspension bridge & HarbourSide	There won't be any props needed for filming this b-roll or any set dressing.	
Weather conditions: Suspension Bridge	It will be windy so we will stay well away from the cliff edge. It might rain so we will have waterproof camera covers.	
Weather conditions: HarbourSide	There will be wind and it is water side so we'll have to stay away from the water edge so that we and kit won't fall into the water.	
Welfare of Cast and Crew on Location: First Aid Emergency procedure Food and Drink Toilets	The worst things that could happen on shoot are falling off the edge of the cliff or dropping kit off the edge. The floor might be wet and muddy so try not to slip and break the kit. At the HarbourSide, the same goes that we'll try not to fall in the water or drop kit in the water.
