# Video Editor for Play Sports Group

#### **Definition**

You'll be working on in-house content with a large post-production team, and will report into the Chief Editor. You will also work closely with the Content Manager, Production Manager and Creative Director to ensure that the vision of GCN+'s documentaries is carried through our content.

### **Key Roles and Responsibilities**

- · Editing premium, long-form content
- · Editing the World of Cycling weekly show
- Mentor Edit Assistants and Creators
- Overseeing projects for documentaries and the World of Cycling
- Ensure permission and rights for any licensed material used (music, images etc)
- Keep up to date with emerging cycling industry trends

## Job Requirements

- 2+ years agency or in-house video editing experience
- Adobe Premiere Pro, Final Cut Pro or similar skills
- Motion graphics / design experience
- Music and sound editing skills
- Ideally, you will have weekly-show or television show editing experience

## **Pathways**

There are two main way to become a video editor:

Film school/college/university

This, yet again, is the easier route to take into the industry as you will be developing your skills over the time it would take you to find an apprenticeship role or full time job as a video editor. For the job role I looked at, they require a minimum of 2 years experience with editing programmes such as premiere pro or sony vegas. This job is easier to get than a camera operator role as all the different safety procedures and skills you need to know compared to being able to edit a video are in parallel.

#### Apprenticeship/full time job role

Choosing this route is more challenging but is more possible than choosing this route for camera operation. All you need to do is prove you have experience with editing programmes, motion graphics, design experience, music/sound editing skills and TV show editing experience. Doing this will give you the opportunity to work as a video editor in some cases, however there are many different types of editing and media so the job opportunities are endless.
